Local Plans – ongoing reviews

- Sutherland Local Plan intended to replace Golspie and Lairg, North West Sutherland, South and East Sutherland and Tongue and Farr Local Plans
 - Consultation on draft Plan closed February 2008. Finalised Plan expected for consultation Summer 2008
 - Caithness and Wester Ross Local Plans are intended to merge with the resultant Sutherland Local Plan from 2010.

- West Highland and Islands Local Plan intended to replace Skye & Lochalsh and Lochaber Plans and part of the Badenoch and Strathspey Plan
 - Consultation on the draft Plan closed March 2008
-
- Inner Moray Firth Local Plan intended to replace Inverness, Nairn and Ross and Cromarty East Local Plans. Draft plan not yet prepared.
-
- There is to be a Highland Wide Local Development Plan. Draft not yet available. Issues Report due Autumn 2008. Aspirational date for adoption of Plan is 2011.
